



Call for research internship's positions: for incoming students from the EUGLOH European alliance partners

This call is open to all the principal investigators and researchers from Paris Saclay University (grand périmètre)

The EUGLOH European alliance's main goal is to foster student mobility within its partners, through physical, virtual or hybrid mobility, by promoting studies or training opportunities. On that end, the EUGLOH Internship opportunities promote and facilitate research internships for students among the alliance universities. It plays a double role: encouraging internship mobilities for all the students of the alliance but also contributing to the internationalization of our research laboratories.

<u>How?</u> The EUGLOH Internship Platform works as a facilitator for students and laboratories/researchers' matchmaking by providing internships opportunities and simplifying the administrative process. This call is addressed to all the UPSaclay's laboratories/research units and/or researchers willing to welcome EUGLOH students or interns, from 1 week up to 6 months.

Overall process:

- 1. <u>Publicity of the Internship opportunity</u> the internship opportunity description should be entered on the EUGLOH Internships platform. The platform is available with no specific login, here.
- 2. All the EUGLOH students can have access to the internships' offers and can apply via the same platform.
- 3. Researchers will receive all the applications and will select the candidate according to their own prerequisites (based on the CV and motivation letter of the candidate).
- 4. If the provided internship lasts more than 2 months, the PI can apply for the EUGLOH-Internship Gratification program, after the selection process (please refer to page 2).

EUGLOH-UPSaclay Internship Gratification program

Aware of the financial obstacles related to the Internship Gratification (mandatory by French law), UPSaclay launches the EUGLOH-UPSaclay Internship Gratification program: this program can fund Internship's Gratifications for incoming EUGLOH students welcomed at UPSaclay laboratories/research units.

Gratification funding:

- The budget available corresponds to 60 months of internships (546 €/month).
- Funds will be transferred to the laboratories/research units, which must pay the gratification to the intern monthly, according to national rules.

Mobility Grants:

• Internships lasting between 2 and 6 months. Interns can also apply to Erasmus+ funding according to its home institution rules.

Eligible period for funding: until March 2023 at the latest.

Application and selection process:

- 1. The PI identifies and select the intern (please refer to the overall process mentioned before).
- 2. Contact Marketa Capkova (eugloh@universite-paris-saclay.fr), providing
 - a. Copy of the internship offer
 - b. Copy of the student's acceptation letter
- 3. The selection will be made on the basis of the eligibility criteria length of the internship.

NB: One-month internships are not eligible for Gratification (French national rules), but students can apply for EUGLOH mobility grant at their home institution.
