



EUGLOH-UPSaclay Research Cooperation Program

Call for Applications



The **EUGLOH** (European University Alliance for Global Health) is a strategic long-term partnership between the Paris-Saclay University, Lund University, Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München, University of Porto and the University of Szeged. Within the EUGLOH network, a balanced interfaculty consortium of researchers and students develops interdisciplinary activities particularly in education and training related to Global Health.

The EUGLOH-UPSaclay Research Cooperation Program is established to extend and deepen the collaboration between the Alliance partner universities. It is intended to support and promote innovative research and training across Global Health disciplines and to foster student's and young researchers' mobility within EUGLOH partner universities.

The EUGLOH-UPSaclay Research Cooperation Program supports cooperation projects with a strong potential for institutional impact. Therefore, the submitted projects must be written from the partnership angle, highlighting the impact of planned actions on the development of the cooperation with the partner or the partners universities.

Budget per project: 15 000 € maximum per project:

- Funding will mainly support travels and costs associated with the organization of research and training activities. The program doesn't fund research.
- Each project can combine different types of activities (described below).
- End of funding eligibility: 30th March 2023.
- Participants from the new partner institutions (UiT The Arctic University of Norway, University
 of Alcalá, University of Hamburg, University of Novi Sad) are welcome to participate in the
 projects but are not eligible for financial support.

Typology of eligible activities and costs

PhDs	Up to 2 months	500 €/month 400 € for travel
	From 2 to 12 months	Erasmus+ grant for mobilities 400 € for travel
Post-doc	up to 9 months	500 € /month 400 € for travel
Researchers (PI)	Up to 2 weeks	700 €/week 500€ for travel
	From 2 weeks to 1 month	1500 € 500€ for travel

Workshops, Seminars or Conferences

Funding: 7 500 € max

• Funding mainly support travels (for invited speakers from EUGLOH partners) and costs associated with the organization (video-conference system, catering, etc.)

Application procedure

- Submission platform here
- Required documents to be joined at the submission platform:
 - Application form with detailed description of the project and budget (to be downloaded on the website)
 - o CV of the applicant and all the participants (from UPSacalay and partners)
- The application must be submitted by one PI from UPSaclay (from all the 14 members)
- Applications are open until July 2022 (according to the remaining budget)

Selection procedure

- A selection committee will meet once a month and will evaluate the applications along the way.
- Selection committee members:

 - o Eric Cassan, Deputy VP-Europe, H2020-EUGLOHRIA coordinator
 - Guillaume Garreta, Director of International and European Affairs

- The selection criteria are:
 - Quality of cooperation arrangements
 - Expected results and objectives of the project
 - Number of partners involved (the most the best!)
- A notification letter will be sent to the PI after the decision taken by the selection committee.

Reporting

A report must be submitted to UPSaclay within 2 months after the funding period. A template of reporting will be communicated with the acceptance letter.
